- Understand the opportunities computer networks offer for communication and collaboration.

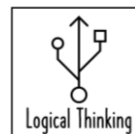
Key person: Mark Zuckerberg

**Mark Elliot Zuckerberg** (born May 14, 1984) is an American internet entrepreneur. He is known for co-founding Facebook, Inc

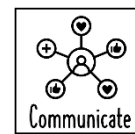


<b>Anchor tag bias</b>	Disproportionate weight given to one perspective, typically because it accords with the author's own view.
<b>Blog</b>	A Website consisting of short articles, presented in reverse date order, typically inviting responses.
<b>Social media</b>	Websites and apps that allow users to create and share content or to participate in conversations with one or more other users.
<b>Web browser</b>	program running on a user's computer which requests and displays web pages using HTTP
<b>World Wide Web</b>	The HTML and other documents stored on individual web servers connected via the Internet and accessible via HTTP
<b>Neutral point of view</b>	A balanced perspective where all sides of an argument are presented fairly.
