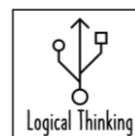
Key person: Mark Zuckerberg

**Mark Elliot Zuckerberg** (born May 14, 1984) is an American internet entrepreneur. He is known for co-founding Facebook, Inc

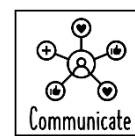


<b>Creative Commons</b>	copyright licensing scheme where the creator of an original work allows others to use it without seeking further permission, subject to a number of agreed conditions
<b>Hyperlinks</b>	text or images that, when clicked, opens another page or moves to another part of the document
<b>Internet</b>	global network connecting computers and local networks using automated switches, routers and fibre optic, copper wire and radio connections
<b>Web browser</b>	program running on a user's computer which requests and displays web pages using HTTP
<b>World Wide Web</b>	The HTML and other documents stored on individual web servers connected via the Internet and accessible via HTTP
<b>Web server</b>	Computer connected to the internet that stores web pages, transmitting these to web brewers as HTTP requests are received
