Key person: Beatrix potter

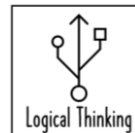
Helen *Beatrix Potter* was an English writer, illustrator, natural scientist and conservationist; she was best known for her children's books featuring animals



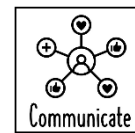
VOCABULARY

Internet	Global network connecting computers and local networks
URL	A standard location on the internet of certain data files. It is used to transmit data.
Web server	A service running on a computer that returns HTML data for a web page when it receives a request via the local network or the internet.
Hyperlinks	Text or image that when clicked opens another page.
Hypertext mark-up language (HTML)	The predominant language for web pages
