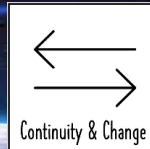

VOCABULARY

Neolithic	The later part of the Stone Age and following the Palaeolithic and Mesolithic Age.
Settlement	A place where there were several Stone Age shelters, like a small village.
prehistoric	Relating to the period before written records.
hunter gatherers	People who mainly live by hunting, fishing and gathering wild fruit.



STICKY KNOWLEDGE

The Stone Age was split into three eras: Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic	The Stone Age started around three million years ago.
The Stone Age was followed by the Bronze Age then the Iron Age	During the Neolithic Age Stone Age man began farming and domesticating animals.
During the Neolithic Age humans formed settled communities	Stone Age man were originally hunter gatherers.
