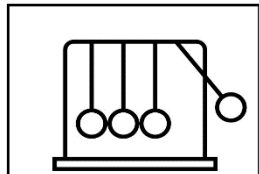
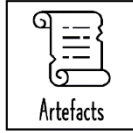
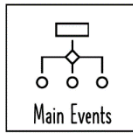

### VOCABULARY

Legacy	The changes made due to a significant event or person that impacts the future
Settlements	Several homes together that create a community.
Tudor house	A home built with features which reference Tudor times
Samuel Pepys	A man who wrote a diary of events during the Great Fire of London
Sir Christopher Wren	A man who helped to redesign London and St Paul's Cathedral
Consequence	A result that is unpleasant.

### STICKY KNOWLEDGE

The Great Fire of London happened in 1666.	The Great Fire of London began in a bakery in Pudding Lane owned by Thomas Farriner
Samuel Pepys wrote a famous diary of the events	In 1666 there was no fire brigade. After the fire the first fire brigade was formed.
The fire spread so quickly because of how the Tudor houses were poorly built and close together.	After the fire, houses were rebuilt of better materials.
