Please see the school policy on our website which outlines our uniform and contains information relating to jewellery, make-up and hair.

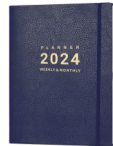

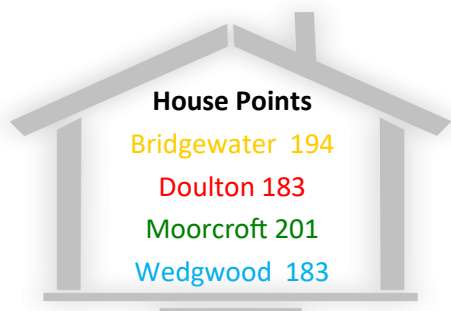
