VOCABULARY

Village	A small settlement.
City	A large town.
Human Feature	How humans have altered the environment (buildings, bridges etc.)
Physical Feature	Natural landscape (beaches, forests, rivers etc.)

STICKY KNOWLEDGE

- Villages have a small number of houses for a few hundred people. Most villages are found in the countryside.
- An advantage living in a village is that there is less air pollution, but there are also fewer jobs. Alton is a village in Staffordshire.
- Cities are the largest kind of settlements and often have millions of people living in them. Manchester is a city.
- An advantage of living in a city is there is better public transport, however there is also more noise and pollution.
