The Tudors came to power after the Battle of Bosworth when Henry Tudor defeated Richard III.	Henry VIII had 6 wives: Catherine of Aragon, Anne Boleyn, Jane Seymour, Anne of Cleves, Kathryn Howard, Katherine Parr.
Henry married six times because he wanted a male heir.	The Tudors reigned England from 1485 to 1603.
Henry split the English Church from the Roman Catholic Church, and declared himself as head of the Church of England	Henry closed down the wealthy Roman Catholic Abbeys, convents and monasteries and took ownership of the buildings, land and money
