The Great Fire of London happened in 1666.	The Great Fire of London began in a bakery in Pudding Lane owned by Thomas Farriner
Samuel Pepys wrote a famous diary of the events	In 1666 there was no fire brigade. After the fire the first fire brigade was formed.
The fire spread so quickly because of how the Tudor houses were poorly built and close together.	After the fire, houses were rebuilt of better materials.

TIER THREE VOCABULARY

Pitch	A thick, black, sticky material made from coal or wood tar used for covering roofs to protect them from water.
Tudor	An era of British history from 1485 - 1603
Thatched roof	A roof built with dry vegetation such as straw or water reed.
