## WHAT SHOULD I ALREADY KNOW?

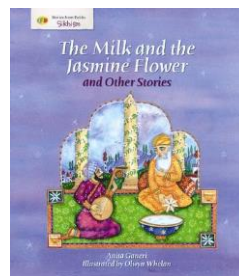
- I have met Rev. Janet the vicar of St. James' Church, Newchapel.
