Parable	a simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson

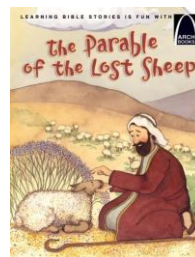
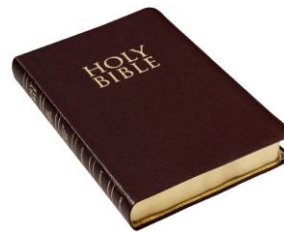
STICKY KNOWLEDGE
