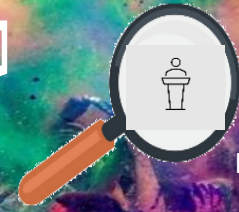

VOCABULARY

Buddha	Indian religious leader: founder of Buddhism. He became known as the Buddha , which means 'enlightened'.
Vihara	A Buddhist temple
Shrine	A place regarded as holy because of its associations with a divinity or a sacred person

STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Buddhists follow the teachings of a man called **Siddhattha Gotama**. He became known as the **Buddha**, which means 'enlightened'.

Buddhists try to live a good life by following the Buddha's teachings, helping them to avoid suffering and bad feelings.

Puja is a worship ritual performed by **Hindus** and **Buddhists**


The eightfold path is Right Understanding, Right Intent, Right Speech, Right Action, Right Livelihood, Right Effort, Right Mindfulness, and Right Concentration.
