Rak'ahs	name used for the series of movements performed during salah prayer


STICKY KNOWLEDGE

Muslim public worship takes place in a Mosque

Before worshipping Allah, Muslims perform ritual washing called wudu.

Muslims pray in the direction of Mecca. They complete several rak'ahs of salah.
