Valkyries

Valkyries are lesser goddesses in <u>Norse</u> Mythology. They serve the chief god Odin. Their task is to choose those who have died in the most <u>heroic</u> way in battle. The Valkyrie then carries the chosen one off to <u>Valhalla</u>. This chosen one would then be called <u>einherjars</u>. They would fight at Odin's side at Ragnarok, the battle at the end of the world. In Valhalla, the Valkyries would also serve drink and care for the well-being of the feasting warriors. The old Norse people thought that Valkyries rode giant wolves, and that they had black wings which correspond to ravens.

Viking homes...

Viking's lived in narrow houses called longhouses which were often found in the countryside. Viking houses in cities such as York would have been smaller.



Longhouses were usually made of wood, stone or earth and turf, which kept out the cold better. They had no chimney or windows, so smoke from the open fire drifted out through the roof.
